## SAMODIVSKI MOTIFS


Long-legged *samodivi*, or female fairies, swirl in a wild dance.

## Banner-Bearers/Acrobats Narni, Italy

The troupe was founded in 1980 and consists of banner-bearers/acrobats who offer a unique and colorful performance accompanied by drums and brass band music. The artists' movements follow the musical rhythm, which changes from slow to frenetic and back.

Their performance is an authentic historical reenactment in which the banner-bearers are divided into small and large groups with traditional combinations of one, two or three banners. The Skermalia drill, which tells of the military origins of the banner, is a special highlight of the program.

Naria Inri Magaria /NIM/ is group of young artists who work with dance, fire and experimental performance. The group functions on the basis of open artistic projects. It traditionally presents shows consisting of two to 10 performers. They specialize in performances with fire, stilts, and various light and fire installations. In their projects, they work with various designers, set designers, musicians, VJs and performers from different countries.

They create their visual productions by preparing choreography for each specific engagement, using a variety of techniques and effects. They prefer to experiment with new directions and to combine various movement techniques and styles in order to interpret different themes. The performances they use various implements including: fire rings, ropes, short and long sticks, double-length sticks, stilts, special costumes, masks, fire installations and sculptures.

Drums – 4 Dance/s/ is realization of the expressive form of the modern dance and movement theatre. The universal message presents four stages of human life: from the merry childhood to the fulfilled old age.

The message is expressed by ritual movement and dance with no words but only with music and theatre language. The rhythm of life is performed by the academic percussion trio PERKURSORS together with our actors, who dance, puppeteer (bunrak technique) and mime. The performance can be shown both in the open air and indoors.

*The Alojzy Smolka Puppet and Actor Theatre in Opole as one of the most eminent contemporary puppet theatres in Poland and Europe is frequently invited to various festivals and presentations home and abroad. The artists have received numerous awards.*

*Founded in 1937, the theatre is one of the longest-performing Polish puppet theatres. A wide range of the best theatre artists: directors, actors, stage directors and musicians have worked on our stage. Since 1962 we have organized the National Festival of Puppet Theatres – one of the most important events of the Polish puppet and theatre community.*

It is a make up of totally unexpected, silent sketches, based on a loose script, where the actors may improvise and act relatively freely. The audience also interacts in certain parts of action thus contributing to the creation of a spectacle full of humor and vivid plot. "The craze of the day" comprises all the elements that have made the Street Theatre so popular to the vast audience.

*Helix Street Theatre was founded in 1987. Its perfect, professionally organized shows, vivid and impressive, guarantee success through the participation of the audience. They comprise all the elements to provide a strong, lively spectacle, full of joy, entertainment and deep meanings. The group is professionally trained in acrobatics, stilts, logging and the art of street performing, and is perfectly competent to provide an exquisite spectacle for children as well as adults using fanciful scenery and costumes, selected music, theatrical lighting, element of fire and fireworks.*

*Helix Street Theatre has toured almost all around Greece, participating various events and festivals. It has also participated in several festivals in United Kingdom (Festival Fringe Edinburgh), India, Cyprus, Bulgaria, Belarus and International Festival for Experimental Theatre of Cairo, Egypt.*

*The theater originally consisted of two artistic troupes: one for dramatic and the other for puppet arts. Later, two separate theaters were formed on this basis: the Dimitar Dimov State Theater and the F. Filipov State Theater, giving each of the two troupes separate stages.*

*The puppeteers creative work has been positively affected by the addition of 10 young actors who graduated in puppet arts from the Kr. Sarafov National Academy of Theater and Film Arts – Софийа. Under the direction of Professor Rumen Rachev, this group has put on many plays. Bulgarian masters of puppet theater directing, Professor Nikolina Georgieva and Professor Atanas Ilkov, have also presented works on the theater's stage.*

The Tale of the Priest at His Servant Glupan contains typical Russian splendor and harmony. The priest is looking for servant who is simultaneously a "horseman, cook and worker." But he should also be "hard-working, cheap and obedient." One day at the market he comes across Glupan, who agrees to become his servant, but only under the condition that one day "instead of receiving a salary, Glupan will hit the priest on the head." The priest sets impossible tasks for his new worker. With skill, cleverness and agility Glupan manages to overcome every challenge.

*Founded in 1946 by Mara Penkova, who used her own meager resources to fund the troupe in those lean post-war years, the first Bulgarian puppet theater quickly succeeded in capturing the public's attention.*

*The theater's first international appearance took place in Bucharest in 1958, and only a mere two years later, the troupe received an award for "Originality and Imagination" at the Second Annual International Puppetry Festival in Bucharest for its adaptation of Sergey Prokofiev's "Peter and the Wolf", directed by Atanas Ilkov and Nikolina Georgieva.*

*The 1960s were the theater's golden era, characterized by highly successful performances that spread the theater's reputation for high-caliber and wildly popular puppet productions throughout the world, from Cuba to the U.S. and Canada, and from Western Europe to as far away as Japan.*

*To date, the puppet theater has staged more than 300 different plays.*

After many adventures he realizes that neither money nor any magical powers can make somebody really happy. Only tolerance and humanity have the power to create warmth and affection between people. And in this world every single piece has its particular place, and sometimes even the tiniest pieces are of utmost significance.

It's a story that tells us that he who has a noble heart, is the one truly rich.

On a whirlwind trip from cradle to grave Nola Rae paints an astonishing portrait of Mozart the clown. A blend of puppets, mime and buffoonery conjures up an orchestra of characters and in the end it is hard to believe there is only one performer on stage. Mozart rampages through his extraordinary life, from child prodigy, manipulated by his father Leopold, to despairing genius, worn out and sinking into an early grave. It is a performance both playfully hilarious and deeply moving. The triumphant child never left the man and the man could never triumph like the child.

*Nola Rae was born in Sydney and immigrated to London with her family in 1963. She trained at the Royal Ballet School in London and then danced professionally at Malmo Stadsteater and Tivoli Pantomime Theatre in Copenhagen, before turning to mime and studying with Marcel Marceau in Paris. She was a founder member of the French based International Research Troupe Kiss, co-founded Friends Readshow with Jango Edwards, and member of Bristol Old Vic Company. In 1974 she founded the London Mimi Theatre with Matthew Ridout, with whom she has worked ever since. Nola premiered her first solo show at Le Festival du Monde in Nancy in 1975. Since then she has created 12 full length shows and toured the world. Her unique combination of mime, clowning, puppetry, dance and foolery has been seen in 65 countries to date.*

## THE ADVENTURES OF ROLAND

"The Adventures of Roland" is a theatrical performance whose main characters are Charlemagne's paladins, brought to life with an unusual kind of marionette called "pupi." These armored puppets are characteristic for the folk epics which gained popularity in Naples and Rome and reached their zenith during the first half of the 19th century in Sicily.

Unlike the *buratino*-style puppet, which is manipulated from below by the fingers, and also unlike the marionette, which is controlled from above by strings, *pupi* are controlled by the head and the right hand using metal rods.

*Pupi* bring to the stage scenes from the *Song of Roland* and other chivalrous romances. Richly decorated and exquisitely carved, the marionettes have a wooden base covered in armor. Every puppet represents a specific paladin, distinguishable by his unique armor and cloak; spectators of this theater usually have their favorite hero whom they root for.

*Emanuele Macri's theater is an heir of the art of puppeteer Cavalier Macri, who died at a young age. The techniques, means of expression and "battle" style were taken from him. And until now, the structure of the puppets and the set design has followed his style as well.*

*The most popular performances are "The Song of Roland" and "Liberated Jerusalem," but children's fairytales are also available.*

*The troupe has participated in festivals in Europe, Africa and America, and has been featured in films and on television. They have received many prestigious international awards.*

*The 1960s were the theater's golden era, characterized by highly successful performances that spread the theater's reputation for high-caliber and wildly popular puppet productions throughout the world, from Cuba to the U.S. and Canada, and from Western Europe to as far away as Japan.*

*To date, the puppet theater has staged more than 300 different plays.*
